MASKING AND COVID POLICY

MASK POLICY

We no longer require that people who enter our practice space wear a mask. *

VACCINATION POLICY

- Proof of vaccination is no longer required. *

SOCIAL DISTANCING POLICY

- We recommend all students remain socially distant, when possible, within the practice space.

EXPOSURE AND REPORTING POLICY

- If an individual DOES have a known exposure to COVID-19 or has displayed symptoms of COVID-19 in the last 14 days prior to class the student must get a COVID-19 test and the following must be followed based on the result:
 - If an individual tests positive, they remain in isolation for 5 days from the end of symptoms. They do not need to retest after the stated isolation period but should continue to mask and social distance when returning to activities (per CDC guidelines).
 - If an individual tests negative, they are welcome to immediately return to activities.
- If an individual believes they have had any exposure to COVID-19, they shall immediately cease entering our facility and shall alert the teacher if they have been on the premises since their exposure.

AN IMPORTANT NOTE ABOUT VENTILATION

- The exterior doors will be open during all classes no matter the outside temperature. Please dress accordingly.

*** Subject to change. If COVID 19 case numbers rise in King County, SKT may once again require the use of a well-fitting N95 or Kn95 masks while indoors and or require proof of vaccination.**
